How

- **Contact the CIAAA at info@ciaaa.ca and let us know you are interested in becoming a Leadership Training Program instructor**

- Let us know what courses you are interested in teaching

Note: you must take the course before you can present it

- **Complete the following steps (in any order)**

- Present a 60 minute CIAAA workshop
 - Great if you develop it as well!
- Complete LTP 790C: Instructor Development for the Leadership Training Program
 - Speak with your 790C Instructor about their CIAAA instructor experience.

- **Serve as a second instructor on a Leadership Training Program course**

- The lead instructor will work with you and assign responsibilities for the course and will provide support and guidance on your sections.
- Take part in a follow-up discussion with the lead instructor to debrief the course presentation and make notes for your future presentations

- **Serve as the lead instructor for a Leadership Training Program course with an experienced instructor supporting your presentation**

- You will take the lead on the presentation and responsibilities and you will have an experienced instructor support you during your presentation.
- Take part in a follow-up discussion with your supporting instructor to further fine tune your presentation.

- **Instruct Leadership Training Courses on your own!**

- You are the lead instructor!
